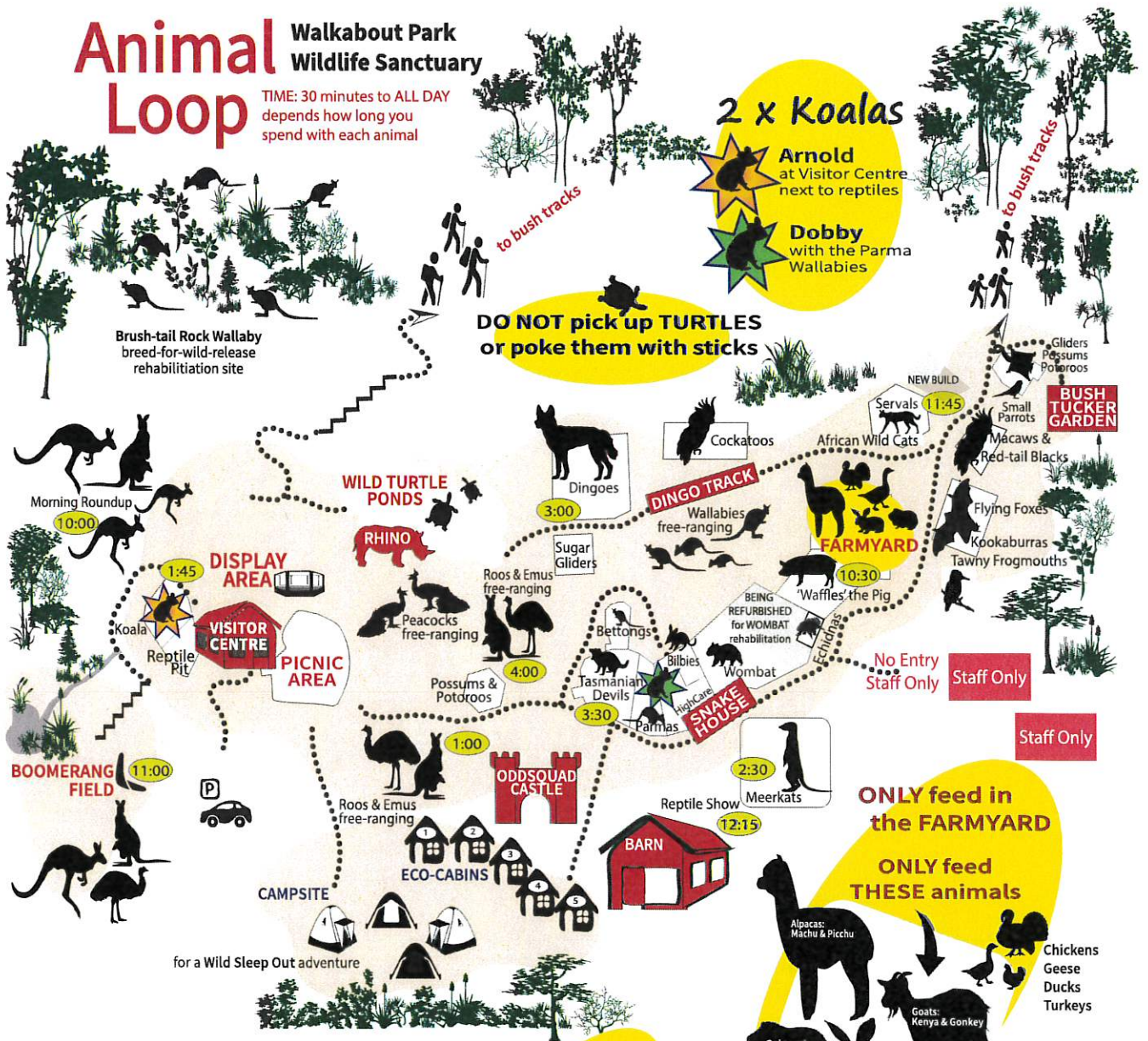


# Animal Loop

## Walkabout Park Wildlife Sanctuary

TIME: 30 minutes to ALL DAY depends how long you spend with each animal



### Do not touch Zoe



Zoë is the only kangaroo wearing a collar.

Zoë is not dangerous, but she has attitude and long claws. We love her, but even the staff NEVER touch her. She can get irritable with people, and she may scratch.

### Feeding wildlife is bad for animals and dangerous for people...

### DO NOT feed EMUS or KANGAROOS or WALLABIES

Our animals are gentle with people and safe with children BECAUSE we never let them learn to take food from people so they never learn to be "grabby" and hurt people.

### DO NOT stand in front of a kangaroo

Do NOT touch it on the HEAD, NECK, CHEST or SHOULDERS even if it seems to like it. This is how kangaroos tell each other they want to fight.

The friendly way to touch a kangaroo is to stand on the side and touch on its back.



If an animal moves away from you it doesn't want to hang out with you. Do not follow it. Do not chase animals. You will scare the animal and a frightened animal might bite or scratch.

ONLY eat INSIDE a fenced area Please don't walk around with food. Only eat inside the fenced picnic area, or on the veranda of the Visitor Centre.
