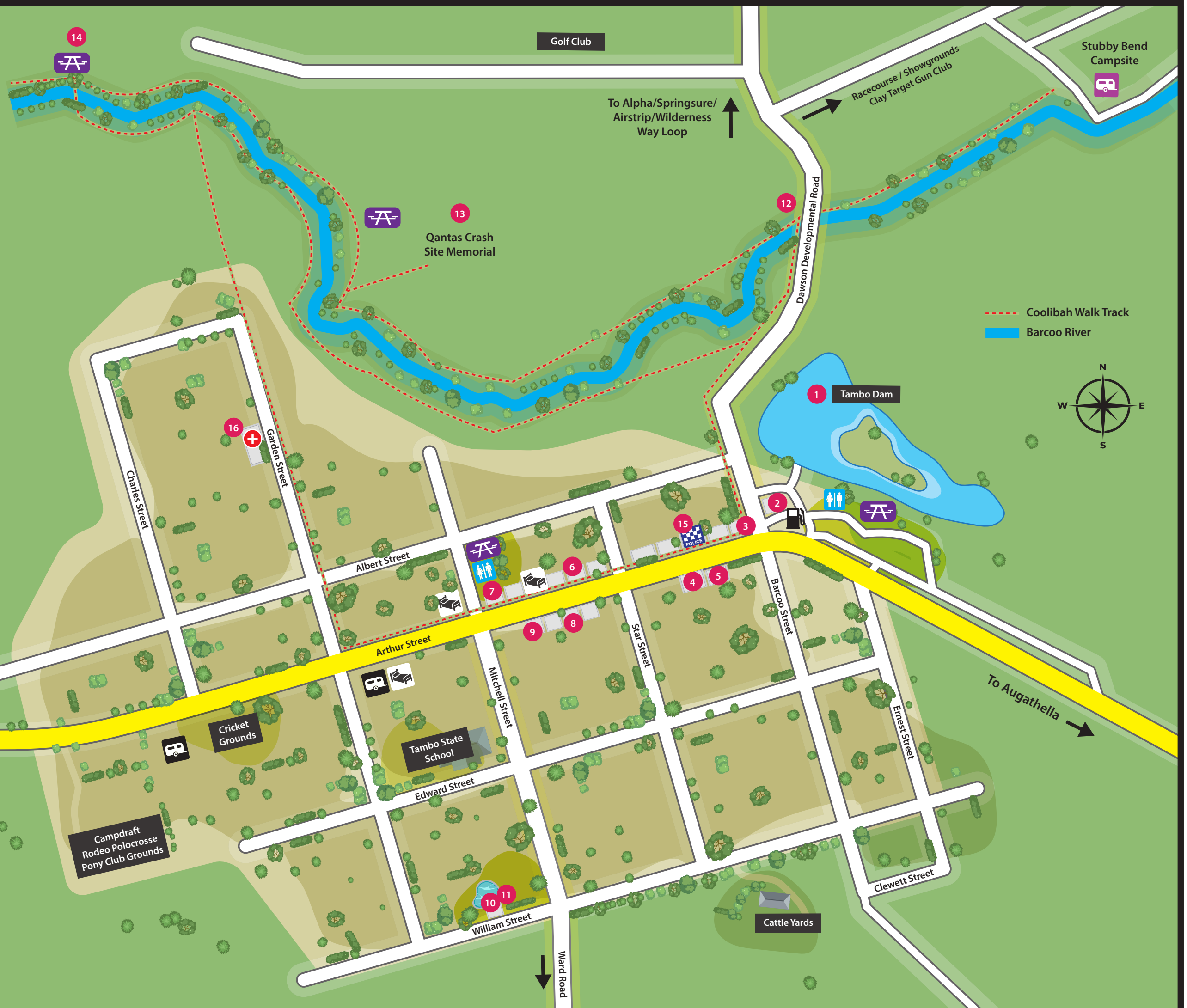

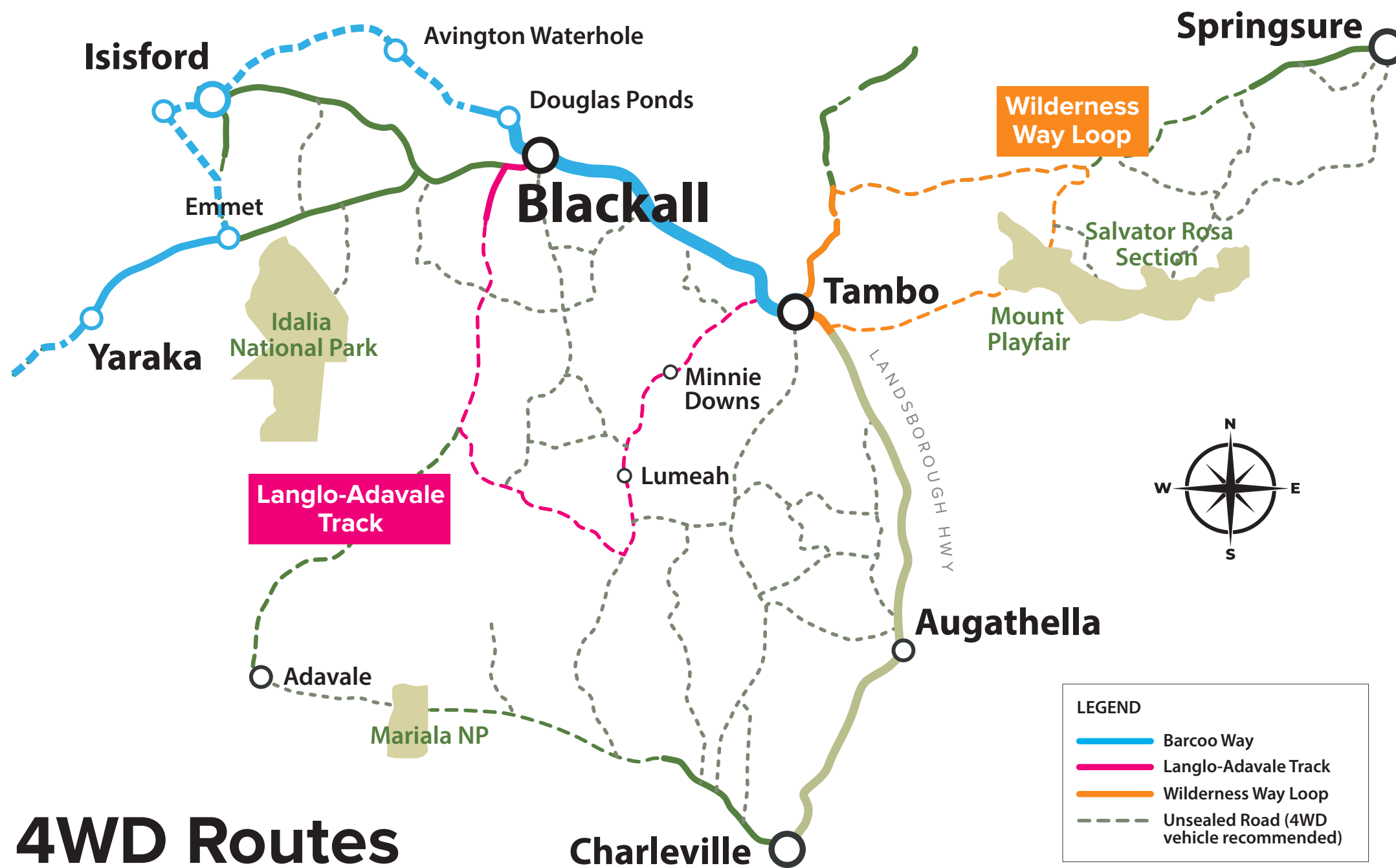

## Wilderness Way

The Wilderness Way is 320km trip which is a self-guided tour that introduces visitors to the rugged beauty of sandstone formations created by wind and rain. Drive through a picturesque broad valley beneath a striking skyline of sandstone formations. Wildflowers commence their bright displays in July with the bright yellows of the wattle leading the way.

**Salvator Rosa** Set up your camp at the Nagoa River Camping area before taking some of the walking tracks or explore the sites along Salvator Rosa Scenic Drive.

**Travel Safely** Roads in this area are true bush roads so be prepared for loose gravel and rough gullies. Roads become impassable after rain. Leave all gates as you find them, slow down when passing other vehicles and be wary of wildlife and livestock on the roads.

Stubby Bend offers those travellers who are totally self-contained can stay free of charge at Stubby Bend for up to three nights.
