Uniquely Toodyay is located in the heritage building that was the former post office. Locally produced products include: macadamia nuts, jams, chutneys, sauces, certified organic honey and bee pollen, pastured eggs, olive oil, stone ground spelt flour and lime cordial. All businesses on the trail are on Facebook and/or Instagram. Tag our businesses and visitor region to help other people enjoy our Food & Picnic Trail.

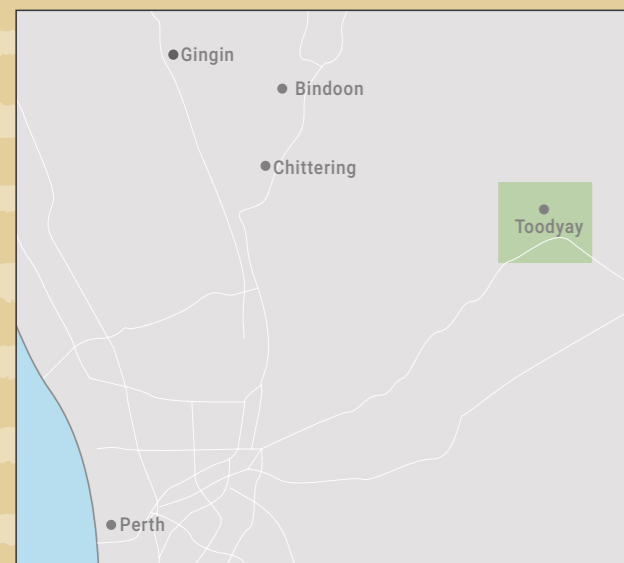

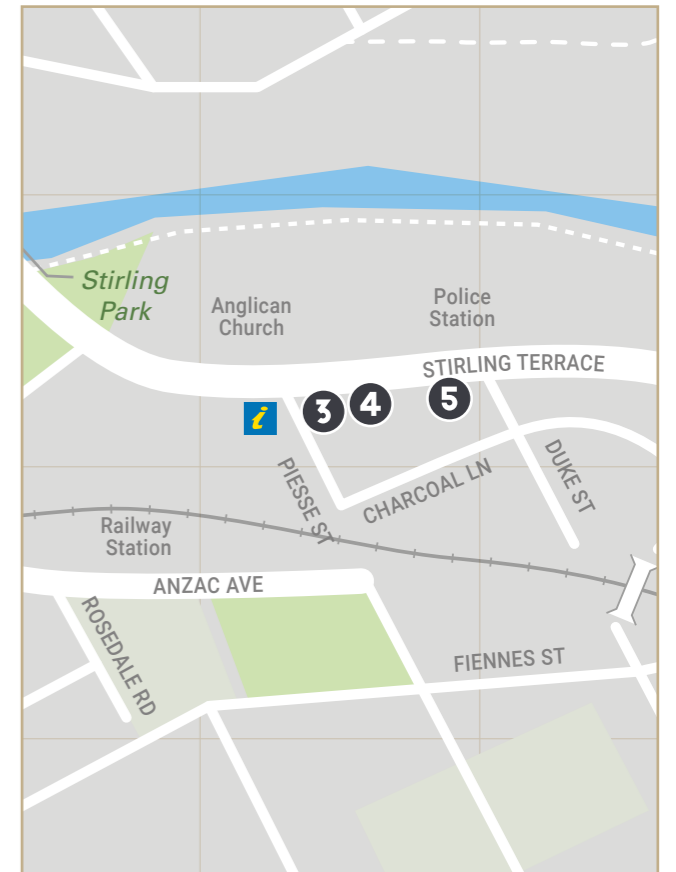
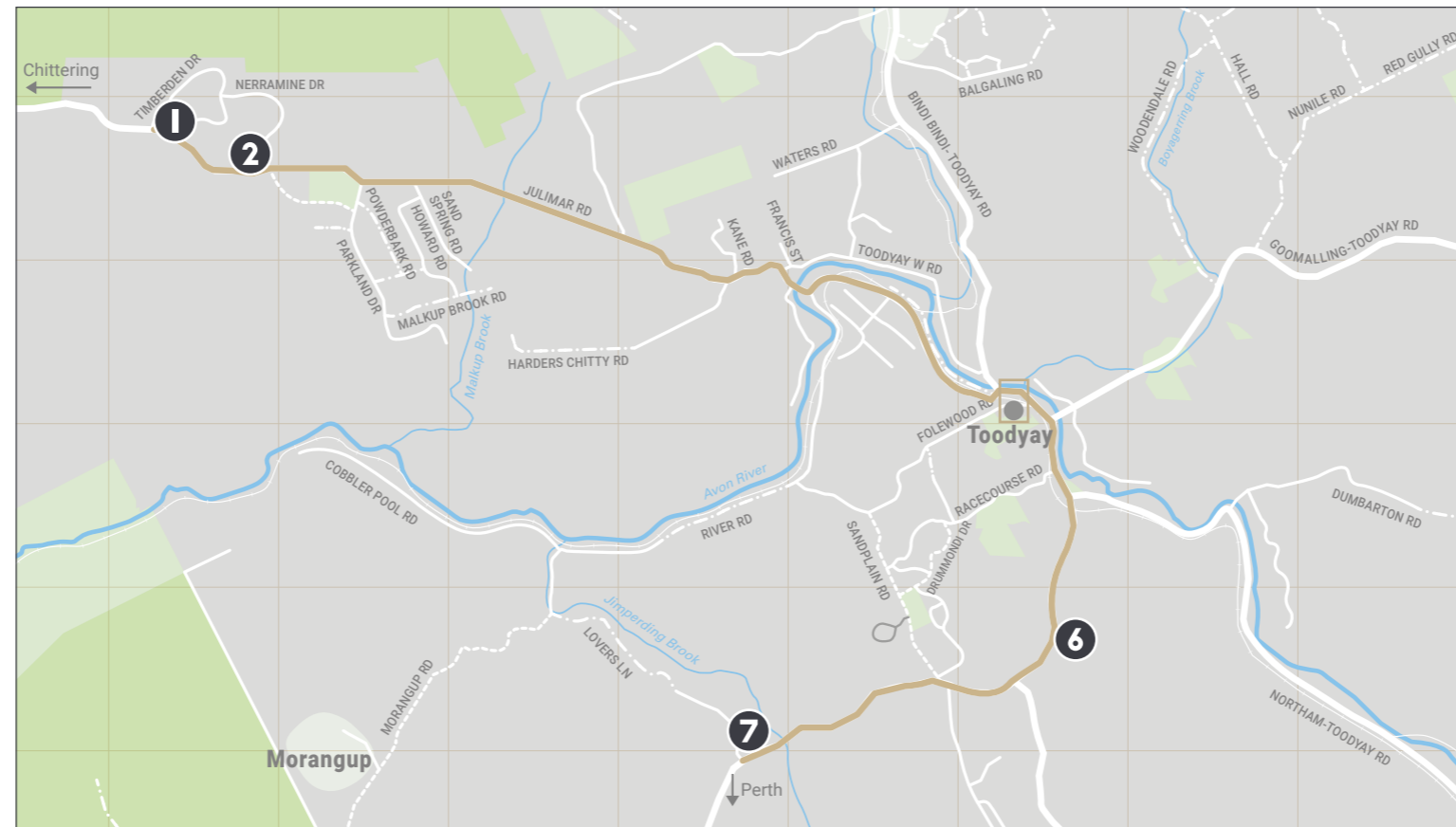
