CAMPING AT HILLOCKS DRIVE (Butler's Beach)

Thank you for choosing to camp at Hillocks Drive. By following a few simple guidelines you will enjoy your stay, have minimal impact on the plants and animals of this area, and ensure that you have a clean, attractive camp site for your next visit.

Bush fires threaten the safety of campers, native animals and vegetation. Please see attached information "Staying Safe from Bush Fire" at Hillocks Drive.

Flush **toilets** and **hot showers** are provided near the shop. Eco toilets are located at the campsites. You may like to bring a portable toilet for your comfort at the campsite.

Litter spoils natural beauty and harms wildlife. Please collect all the litter you see and together we will ensure a pristine bush and marine

environment. Please see our "Rubbish Pack" for more information on rubbish disposal.

Campfires are allowed from 30th April to 1st November. Please bring your own wood or purchase from Hillocks shop. No firewood may be collected from Hillocks bush.

Even small bushes take many years to grow in this harsh coastal environment, please do not drive over, step on or break coastal plants. Thank you for staying on graded roads and well marked tracks.

Your **pets** are welcome to visit Hillocks Drive. Please keep pets on a leash and under control. Pay particular care when walking the beaches between August and March – as this is the nesting season for the endangered Hooded Plover and other coastal species. More information available at the shop.

Bore **water** and rain water are provided free of charge at the shop. Take a container to replenish your supplies.

Please be aware of others comfort with regard to loud noises, generators or invasive pets, and allow polite distance between camps.

Are you interested in supporting the **environmental work** carried out at Hillocks? If so, please offer your assistance at Hillocks Shop, as every small piece of support helps protect our precious eco system.

Off road motor bikes and chain saws are banned at Hillocks Drive. The dunes are not suitable for sand surfing.

Please note the car registration number of anyone not respecting your camping area and report to the shop.

We wish you a very enjoyable bushland and coastal camping experience at Hillocks Drive.
