Welcome to the Blackwood River Valley

The Blackwood River Valley is the heart of food production in the southwest.

The region produces one of the widest ranges of food in Western Australia. Get set to experience what the region has to offer on the stunning Blackwood River Valley Food & Beverage Trail. In season, you can taste sweet chestnuts, local honey, sheep's cheese, local cider and ales and local wines.

Meander around three historic towns. Bridgetown, the Winter Capital of WA. Nannup, one of the best preserved 1950's towns in WA and Balingup, famous for its Medieval Festival held every August.

Every season brings a new look to the valley. In autumn experience one of the five best places in Australia to see Autumn colour as recognised by QANTAS, in winter enjoy a log fire in one of the many accommodation venues, in spring marvel at the wild flowers and in summer see why the area is often called the Tuscany of the south west.

Stay a night, or a few days and explore the farms, gardens, restaurants and forests. Enjoy all the Blackwood River Valley has to offer.

Note: Some of the locations are working farms and may be seasonal or require you to make an appointment if you would like to visit, so please make sure you read the details for each location.

Getting Around

The Blackwood River Valley is conveniently located in the centre of the South West region, approximately 3 hours drive from Perth, providing a great opportunity to use the region as a base to explore the South West which is one of the world’s 36 biodiversity hot spots and its breathtaking scenery. Visitors to Margaret River are less than an hour’s drive on the sealed Mowen Road from the delights of the Blackwood River Valley town of Nannup. Likewise day trips from Busselton and Bunbury, which are also less than an hour’s drive, provide an opportunity to sample the wide range of premium food and produce from the Blackwood River Valley. The best way to experience all that the region has to offer is to self-drive. There are a number of car hire options in Perth available for visitors.

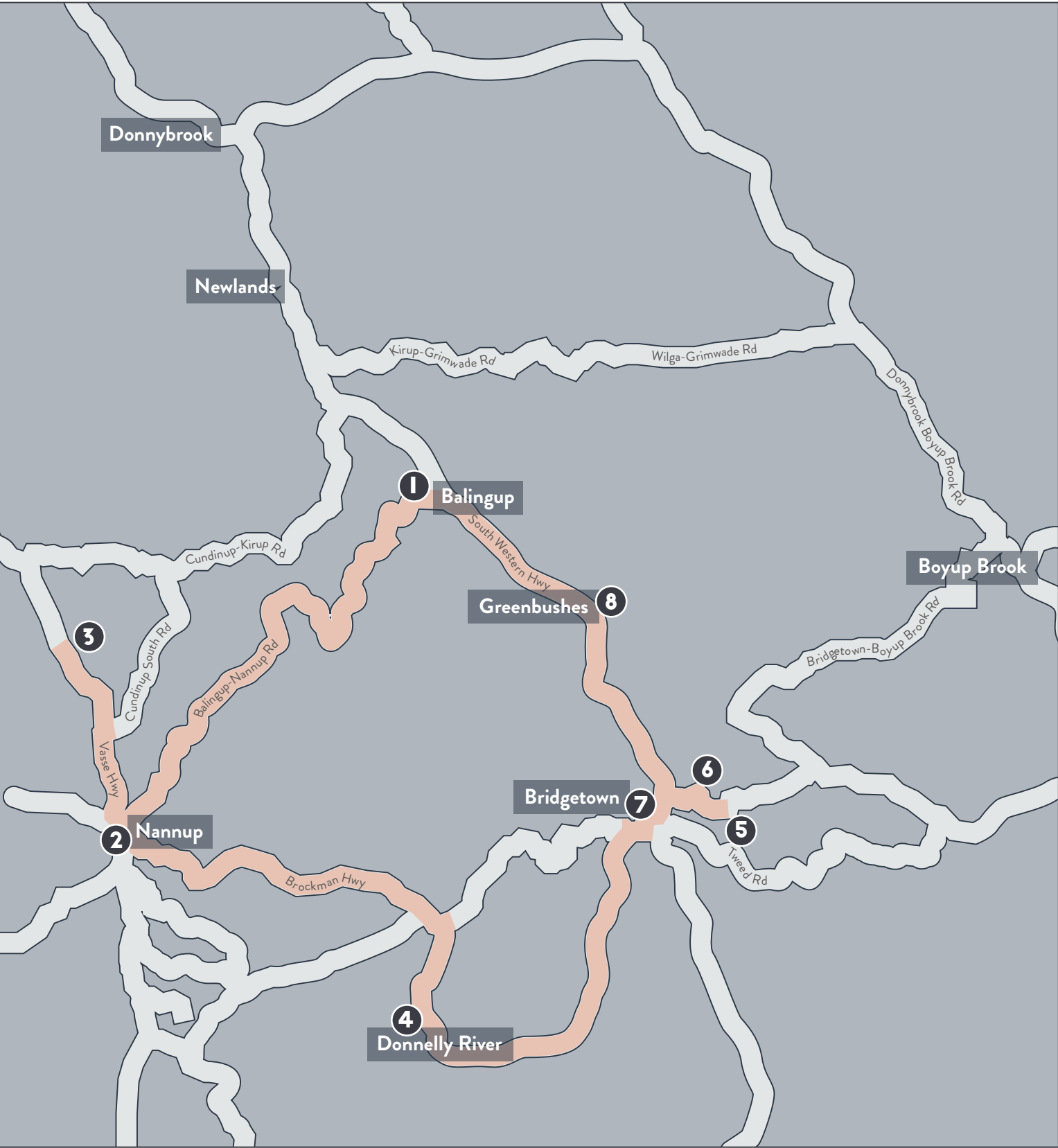
