Let's do a lap with Duffy the Donkey

Follow the Shrine ring-road in this activity trail for pre-schoolers and early primary school-aged children.



Let's find the man and his donkey statue.

STOP 1: Here is the statue of a man named Simpson with his donkey, Duffy.

Together they helped people. Can you see the soldier with his foot bandaged?

NEXT: Let's find the flag poles.

STOP 2: Here are the flagpoles.

How many flag poles can you count? What flags do you see?

NEXT: Let's find the flame.

STOP 3: Here is the flame.

This is called the Eternal Flame. It burns day and night, and never goes out.

NEXT: Let's follow the path around to the back of the Shrine.

STOP 4: You are now at the back of the Shrine.

There is a big triangle up high, what can you see?

STOP 5: There are many steps leading up to the Shrine's Sanctuary.

How many can you count? Can you climb them?

NEXT: Let's find the giant red poppy.

STOP 6: Can you see the poppy through the glass doors?

We wear poppies to help us remember people from the war.

NEXT: Let's find a statue with a mother and her two children.

STOP 7: Here is a statue with children just like you!

This family are remembering someone they loved.
