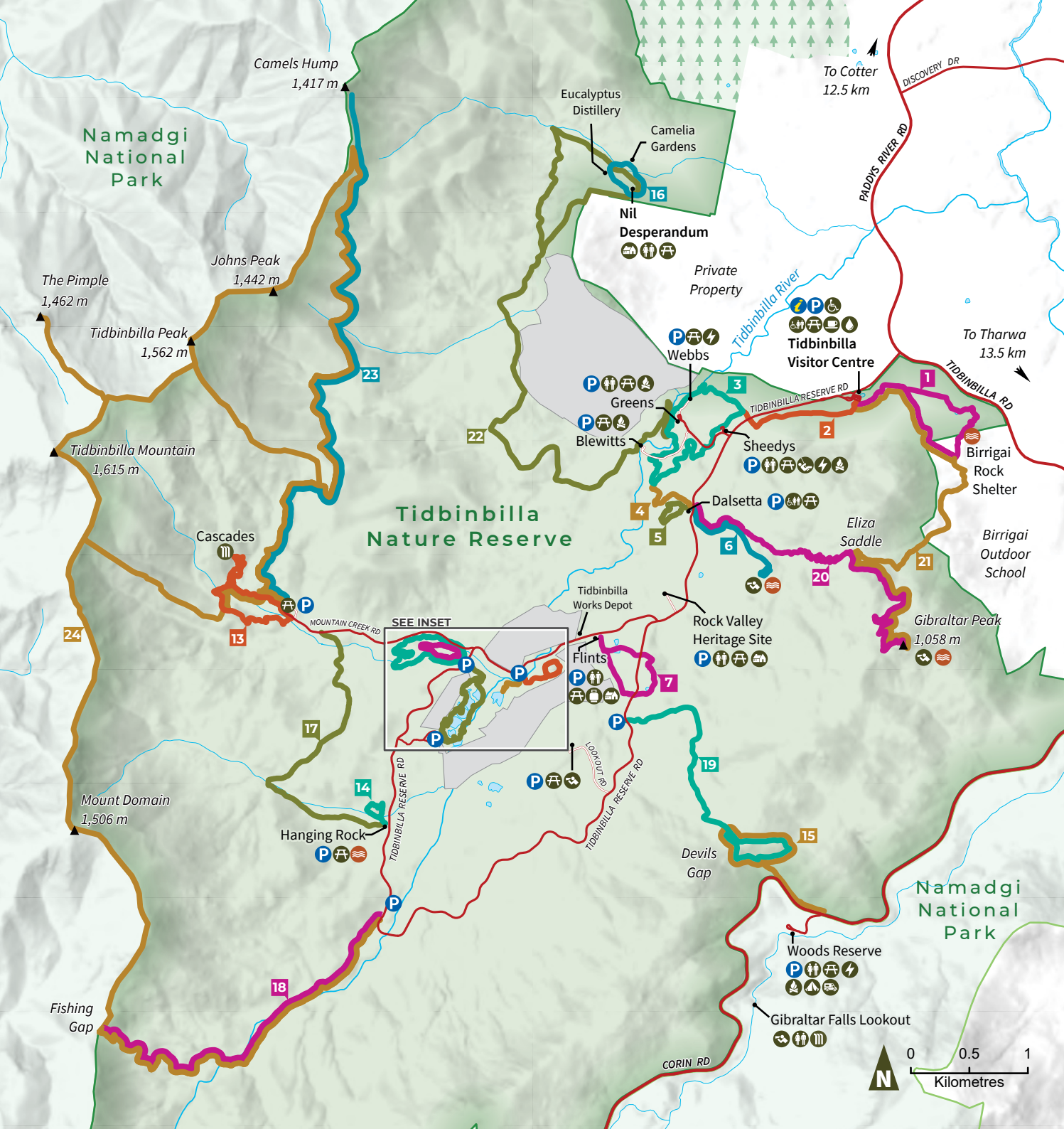

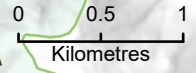

## Leave no trace

- » Leave your pets at home
- » Be aware of fire restrictions
- » Carry it in, carry it out – take your rubbish with you
- » Leave animals, plants and rocks where you find them
- » Got to go? Use a toilet or walk at least 100 paces away from waterways, dig 15 cm deep and cover well
- » Respect heritage sites
- » Stay on track
- » Use fire carefully

## Australian Walking Track Grading System



### Grade 1

No bushwalking experience required. Flat even surface with no steps or steep sections. Suitable for wheelchair users who have someone to assist them.



### Grade 2

No bushwalking experience required. The track is hardened or compacted surface and may have a gentle hill section or sections and occasional steps.



### Grade 3

Suitable for most ages and fitness levels. Some bushwalking experience recommended. Tracks may have short steep hill sections a rough surface and many steps.



### Grade 4

Bushwalking experience recommended. Tracks may be long, rough and very steep. Directional signage may be limited.



### Grade 5

Very experienced bushwalkers with specialised skills, including navigation and emergency first aid. Tracks are likely to be very rough, very steep and unmarked.

## Opening times

Tidbinbilla Nature Reserve is open every day of the year except Christmas Day.

Gates open at **7:30am** and close at **6pm (AEST/Winter)** and **8pm (Daylight Saving Time/Summer)**.

**Tidbinbilla Visitor Centre** is open between **9am** and **5pm**.

The Reserve and Visitor Centre may be closed on days of total fire ban, severe weather events or for management requirements.

## Entry fees

Fees are charged per vehicle, up to 8 people. Entry fees apply during visitor centre opening hours.

Regular visitors can purchase an annual pass, which is valid for a year from date of purchase.
