A man-made rough stone memorial or monument to mark a significant time or historical location.

WHY EAGLE?

We are named in honour of the wedge-tailed eagle, BUNJIL, who are highly aerial and can soar to great heights.

ARTHURS SEAT

Named in 1802 for its resemblance to the hill of Arthurs Seat in Edinburgh. The Aboriginal, Boonwurrung name for the hill is WONGA.
