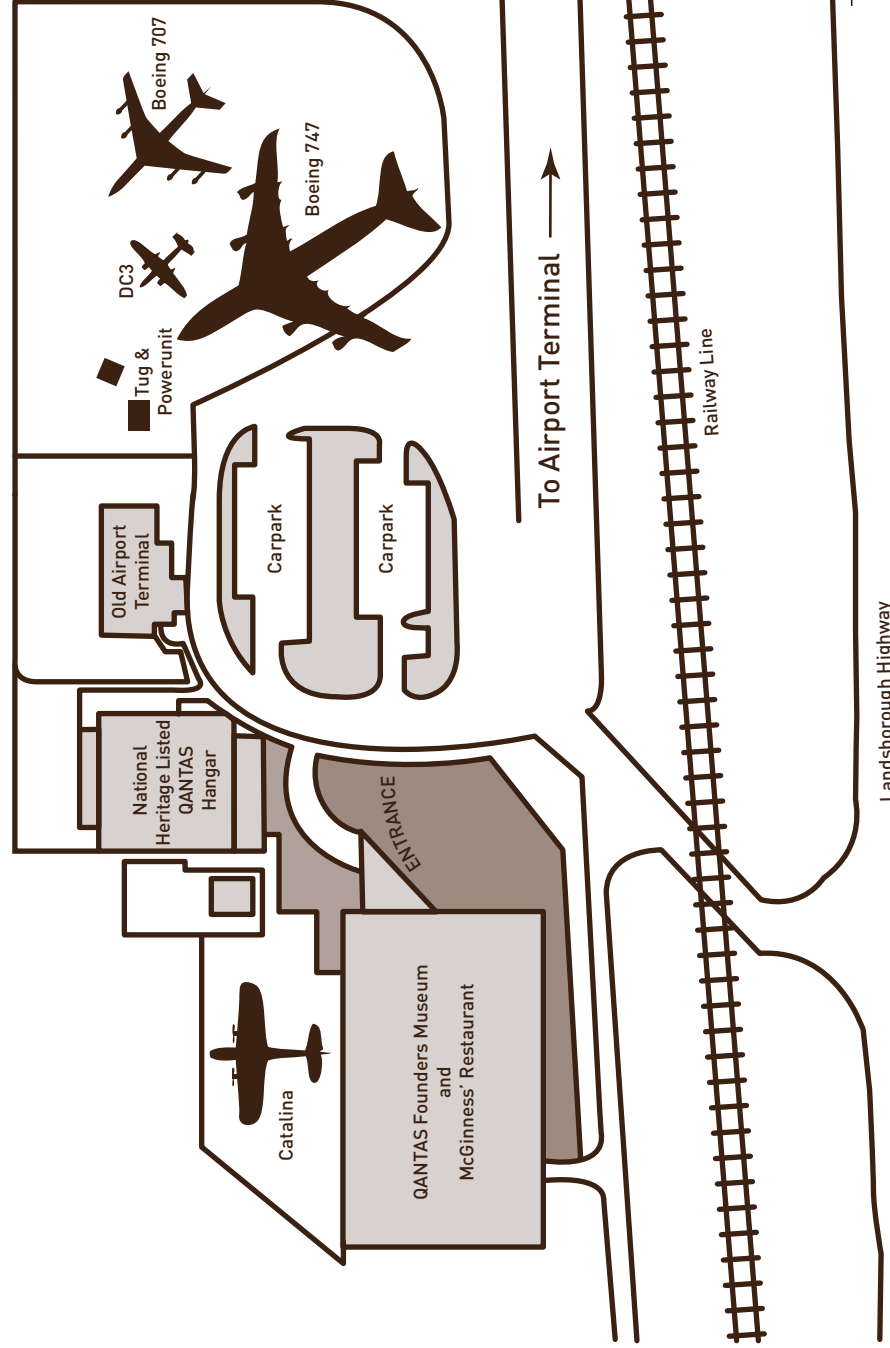
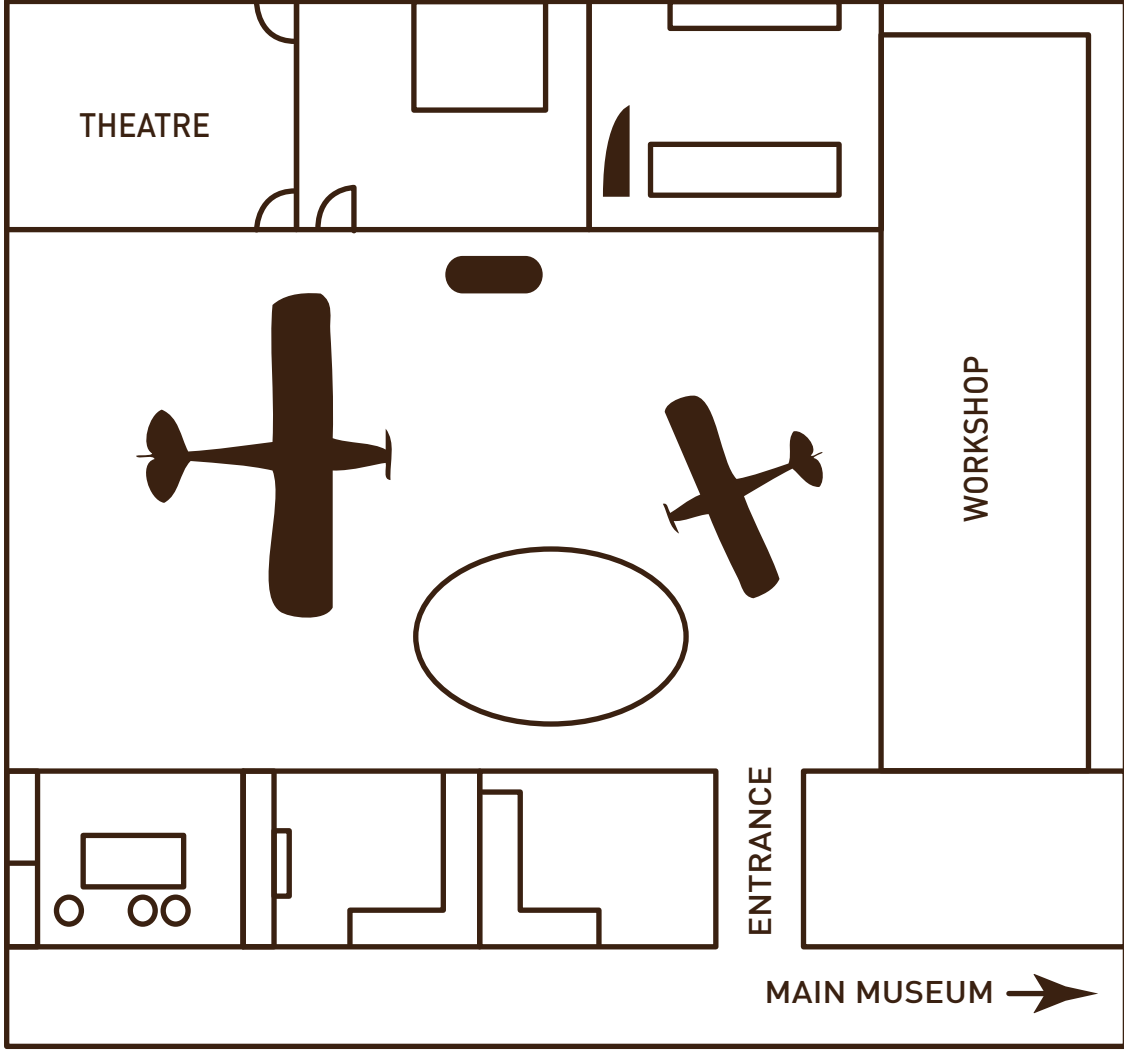

### THE PROJECTS:

#### 1. Transportation and Restoration of the Super Constellation

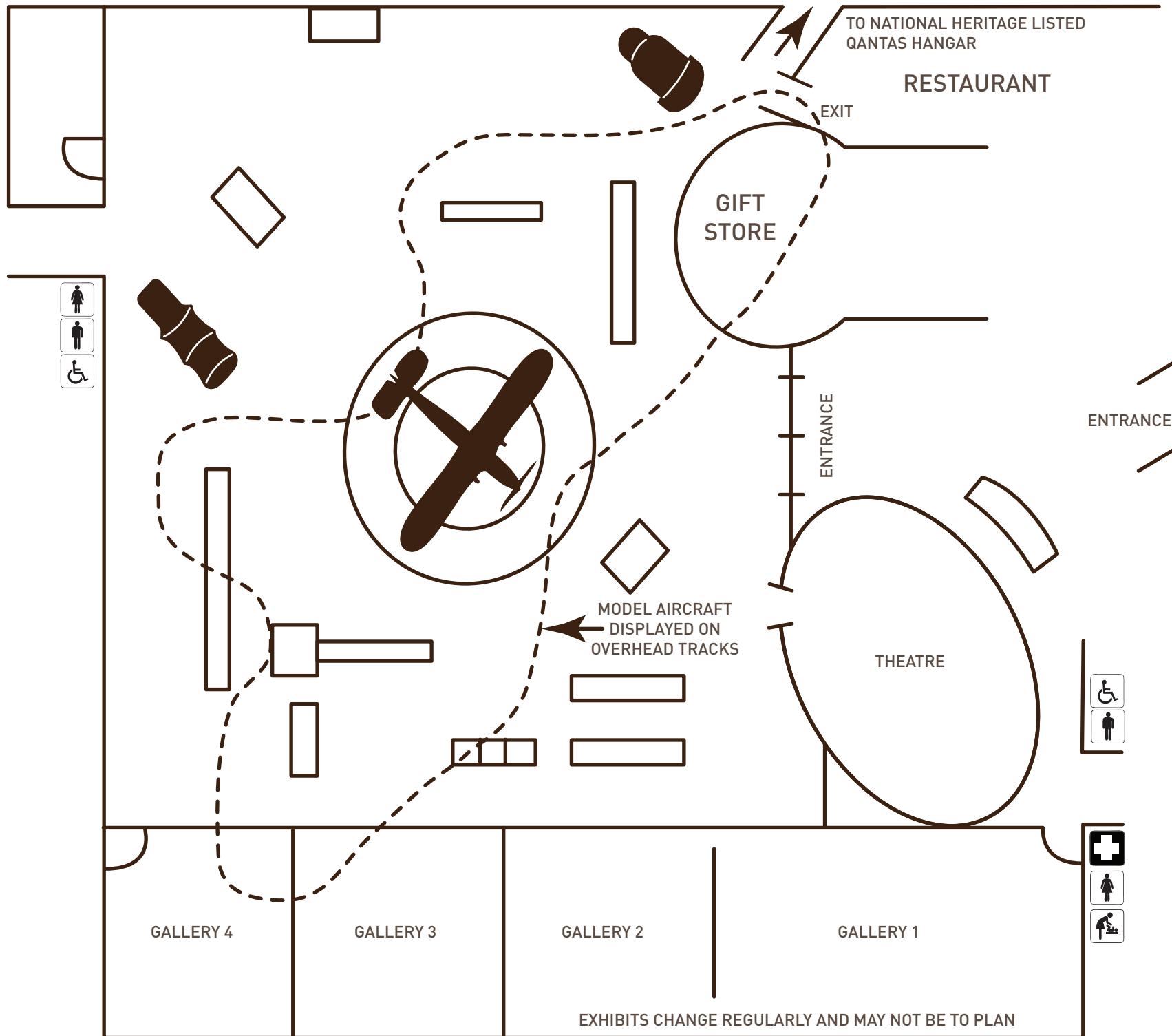
In September 2014 the museum purchased a Super Constellation in Manila to add to the collection. The cost to disassemble and transport the aircraft to Longreach is \$1.5 Million.

#### 2. Aeroplane Enclosure Roof

To ensure the preservation of our national aviation heritage, the museum will engage in a \$7 Million project to build a roof to protect our iconic aircraft.
