STREET OF PEARLS - DAMPIER TERRACE (32)

The historical hub of the pearling industry in Broome has been transformed into a unique retail space where you can buy the highest quality South Sea pearls in the world. Learn about pearling and attend a live pearl harvest and pearl grading sessions. The world's largest, most perfect round pearl lives here and you can find it at the Cygnet Bay Pearls showroom.



SUN PICTURES AND THE JILA (44)

The Sun Pictures opened on 9th December 1916 and is recognised by the Guinness Book of Records as the oldest operating 'Picture Gardens' in the world. The pavement out the front of the picture gardens has a Kimberley stone mosaic representing jila (sacred waterholes) that were part of a large network of jila that linked sites across this country. Yawuru artist Martha Lee created the mosaic, based on a story given to her by Jimmy Edgar.



STREETER'S JETTY (40)

Streeter's Jetty was built for pearl dealers and merchants E. W. Streeter & Co of London in the late 19th century. A channel cut through the mangroves to Dampier Creek provided access to Streeter's Jetty for luggers and other small vessels.



ROEBUCK BAY LOOKOUT (43)

The Roebuck Bay Lookout provides sweeping views over the Roebuck Bay and Dampier Creek. Yawuru artists Martha Lee and Ricky Roe worked with students at Broome Senior High School to create designs for the Lookout. The goanna and other animals on the concrete wall are found on Roebuck Plains and the dramatic Lookout roof reflects the bluenose salmon that breed in Dampier Creek and are a favourite local fish.
